

## DEMOGRAPHIC SITUATION <sup>1</sup> IN UKRAINE IN JANUARY—JUNE 2014

As of 1 July 2014 the population of Ukraine was estimated at 42988,0 thsd. persons. During January—June 2014 the population decreased by 85,1 thsd. persons that amounted to 4,0 persons per 1000 population.

The population decline was exclusively due to natural decrease – 96,0 thsd. persons, concurrently a migration gain – 10,9 thsd. persons was registered.

In comparison with January—June 2013 the volume of a natural decrease increased by 2,5 thsd. persons (from 4,6 to 4,5 persons per 1000 population).

A significant surplus of the number of deaths over live birth remains: per 100 deaths – 71 live births.

The birth rate has increased from 10,3 ‰ in January—June 2013 to 10,8 ‰ in January—June 2014.

The death rate increased from 14,9‰ in January—June 2013 to 15,3‰ in January—June 2014.

At the age under 1 year died 1855 infants. The death rate of infants under 1 year of age remained the same as in January-June 2013 - 7,8 t per 1000 live birth.
