DEMOGRAPHIC SITUATION¹ IN UKRAINE IN JANUARY—NOVEMBER 2014

As of 1 December, 2014 the population of Ukraine was estimated at 42953,9 thsd. persons. During January—November 2014 the population decreased by 119,2 thsd. persons that amounted to 3,0 persons per 1000 population.

The population decline was exclusively due to natural decrease -145,1 thsd. persons, concurrently a migration gain -25,9 thsd. persons was registered.

In comparison with January—November 2013 the volume of a natural decrease increased by 7,6 thsd. persons (from 3,5 to 3,7 persons per 1000 population).

A significant surplus of the number of deaths over live birth remains: per 100 deaths -75 live births.

The birth rate has decreased from 11,1 ‰ in January—November 2013 to 10,9 ‰ in January—November 2014.

The death. in January—November 2014 in comparison with January—November 2013 did not change – 14,6 ‰.

At the age under 1 year died 3321 infants. The death rate of infants under 1 year of age decreased from 8,0 per 1000 live birth in January—November 2013 to 7,7 — in January—November 2014.
