DEMOGRAPHIC SITUATION¹ IN UKRAINE IN JANUARY—OCTOBER 2014

As of 1 November, 2014 the population of Ukraine was estimated at 42965,1 thsd. persons. During January—October 2014 the population decreased by 108,0 thsd. persons that amounted to 3,0 persons per 1000 population.

The population decline was exclusively due to natural decrease -130.0 thsd. persons, concurrently a migration gain -22.0 thsd. persons was registered.

In comparison with January— October 2013 the volume of a natural decrease increased by 4,0 thsd. persons (from 3,5 to 3,6 persons per 1000 population).

A significant surplus of the number of deaths over live birth remains: per 100 deaths - 75 live births.

The birth rate in January—October 2014 in comparison with January—October 2013 did not change -11,1%.

The death rate increased from 14,6 ‰ in January—October 2013 to 14,7‰ in January—October 2014.

At the age under 1 year died 3071 infants. The death rate of infants under 1 year of age decreased from 8,0 per 1000 live birth in January— October 2013 to 7,8— in January— October 2014.
