

## DEMOGRAPHIC SITUATION<sup>1</sup> IN UKRAINE 2014

As of 1 January, 2015 the population of Ukraine was estimated at 42928,9 thsd. persons. During 2014 the population decreased by 144,2 thsd. persons that amounted to 3,4 persons per 1000 population.

The population decline was exclusively due to natural decrease –166,8 thsd. persons, concurrently a migration gain –22,6 thsd. persons was registered.

In comparison with 2013 the volume of a natural decrease increased by 11,9 thsd. persons (from 3,6 to 3,9 persons per 1000 population).

A significant surplus of the number of deaths over live birth remains: per 100 deaths – 74 live births.

The birth rate has decreased from 11,0 ‰ 2013 to 10,8 ‰ in 2014.

The death rate has increased from 14,6 ‰ in 2013 to 14,7‰ in 2014.

At the age under 1 year died 3603 infants. The death rate of infants under 1 year of age decreased from 8,0 per 1000 live birth in 2013 to 7,7 — in 2014.
